In addition, we have noted that the planning of some priorities is related to the negotiation chapters, ie the negotiation chapters are mentioned. Given the new methodology introduced by the EC, it is not entirely clear to us how IPA III will follow the negotiating frameworks of different countries (those applying the old one compared to those applying the new methodology

since there is neither a National housing strategy that adequately recognize, provide mechanisms for the prevention of homelessness nor adequate and timely mechanisms for responding to existing homelessness, nor is there sufficient critical mass in the country's civil society that could be relied on. Homelessness has so far been covered by attempts to address the "Roma issue" systematically, but this phenomenon has not been fully covered.

Need 1: for the state and local governments to adequately recognize the problem, come up with systemic solutions

Need 2: to allocate funds from both domestic and foreign public funds (IPA, etc.) in this direction. It is also necessary to strengthen the service providers while simultaneously developing sustainable and enforceable system solutions.
